Funeral Services for Henry Kenneth Cunnyingham, age 92 of Pike, were held Sunday, Feb. 26, at 2 p.m. at Cross Pointe Baptist Church with Ed Long officiating. Burial followed in the Pike Cemetery. Cunnyingham passed away at Homestead of McKinney on Thursday, Feb. 23, 2012.

Cunnyingham was born Oct. 20, 1919, in Blue Ridge, the son of Elbert Alton and Selma Carlton Cunnyingham. He married Leona Mae Vandagriff in August of 1945 in Pike.
